Georgia Adopt-A-Stream

UCCTU monitors Chattahoochee River tributaries for chemical and bacterial water quality. UCCTU members are also Adopt-a-Stream certified instructors.

Stream Restoration Projects

UCCTU partners with GCTU, the Georgia DNR, the United States Forest Service and others to enhance and restore aquatic habitat in the Chattahoochee's North Georgia tributaries.

Rizzio Fly Fishing Clinic

A comprehensive one-day fly fishing clinic for **young men and women, ages 10 to 15**, who are new to fly fishing. Certified instructors and mentors engage students in a wide range of fly fishing and conservation topics.

Georgia Council Trout Camp

Each summer twenty-four boys and girls, ages 12-15, travel to the Rabun Gap Nacoochee School, in Dillard GA for a week of fly casting, fishing, fly tying and cold water conservation activities. UCCTU sponsors two individuals for the camp.

Trout in the Classroom

An environmental education program in which students in grades K-12 raise trout from eggs to fry; monitor tank water quality; engage in stream habitat studies; learn to appreciate water resources; begin to foster a conservation ethic and grow to understand various ecosystems.
